Fishabout - Mongolia

Mongolia is a unique fly-fishing destination where you can **fly fish for Taimen**, the largest member of the salmon family. Highlights of fly-fishing in Mongolia include clear rivers, abundant fish, tranquil fishing, stunning surroundings and unique culture. For a fishing adventure, Mongolia is the ultimate destination.

DAY 1

On arrival into Ulaanbaatar your Guide will transfer you from the airport to your hotel where you can relax and unwind after your flight. Ulaanbaatar is like being transported back to the 1950's with its Soviet era architecture. You can find huge statues of Stalin, numerous palaces and tranquil monasteries throughout the centre of town. Also highly recommended is having a traditional meal at a local pub with the essential ingredient being horse meat.

- 2210 Arrive Ulaanbaatar
- 2300 Transfer to Hotel



DAY 2

Today you will take a domestic flight to Muron, located 500km North West of the capital. A Jeep will be waiting to take you on your scenic journey to the Delger River. Along the way you will get to experience the local hospitality and try Yurt cheese, milk and yoghurt. Tonight your accommodation is in a traditional ger(Yurt) on the banks of the Delger River.

- 1230 Domestic Flight to Muron
- 1430 Overland by Jeep to river
- 1830 Arrive at Delger River



DAY 3 - 8

The next few days are spent drifting down the Delger River in a float boat, fishing for Taimen, Lenok and Grayling. The water is crystal clear with a gravel bottom which makes it easy to sight cast for the massive Taimen that inhabit these waters. The Taimen's diet consists of gerbils, mice and even ducks which makes for spectacular fishing action. Dry fly is the most appropriate method for Grayling, using small black ant imitations on 14 – 18 size hooks.

- 0700 Float Trip
- 1830 Stop at camp for the night



DAY 9

Today you pack up camp and head back to Muron taking in Mongolia's spectacular beauty along the way. The domestic flight to Ulaanbaatar will have you back in the Capital in time for a relaxing drink after checking into the hotel for your last night.

- 1000 Drive to Muron
- 1455 Domestic flight to Ulaanbaatar
- 1600 Check in to hotel

Camping

Camping is comfortable, with individual tents or 3-person mountain tents for two to share, a dining tent, camp chairs and tables, toilet tent and simple shower. Base camps with gers (yurts) are set up at the put-in and take-out points, giving you space to organise your gear, clean up, and have a night in a bed at each end of the float.

The equipment boats carry all the tents, food and accessories, and by the time you reach each camp site in the evening fires are lit, tents erected and dinner well on the way. There is nothing for you to do except have a drink while sitting around the fire swapping stories of the day's events.



About the trip

The 6-day float fishing trip gives access to rarely fished inaccessible waters. Floating an average of 10 km a day allows you plenty of time to fish the best pools as you travel through the magnificent scenery of the Delger River canyon.

The boats are equipped with casting seats for two fly fishermen and each is rowed by one of your guides. Your guide Andy Parkinson has been fishing these rivers for the past 10 years and is now the premier outfitter in the country. These trips are for adventurous anglers who enjoy comfortable camping, remote travel and exciting fishing in beautiful locations.
